IMPORTANT INFO FOR ALL SLADS MEMBERS...

In accordance with Article VIII, Section I of the SLADS By-Laws, an amendment is being proposed to the membership. The Board has discussed the need for consistency in the Treasurer's office and/or any office. The following options are being presented to the membership via publication in the newsletter and will be voted on during the business portion of the Annual Awards Banquet. Alternate wording, comments or additional amendments can be presented to the President via e-mail at fafetzta@hotmail.com for publication in the newsletter and consideration during the vote.

Article V - Officers

Existing Section 3

No Officer may hold the same office for more than two consecutive terms beginning with the first full term served.

(OPTION 1)

Section 3

No Officer, except the Treasurer, may hold the same office for more than two consecutive terms beginning with the first full term served. The Treasurer may serve as many terms as practical due to the requirements of the office. The Treasurer must notify the Board if not willing to run for additional terms and be available to train and facilitate the transition to a new treasurer (except in extenuating circumstances).

(OPTION 2)

Section 3

Officers may hold the same office for more than two consecutive terms with the approval of the existing Board and ratification by the full membership during the annual election.

SLADS is seeking nominees for Vice President, secretary, and board members at large. Annual election and banquet will be January 27, 2007.

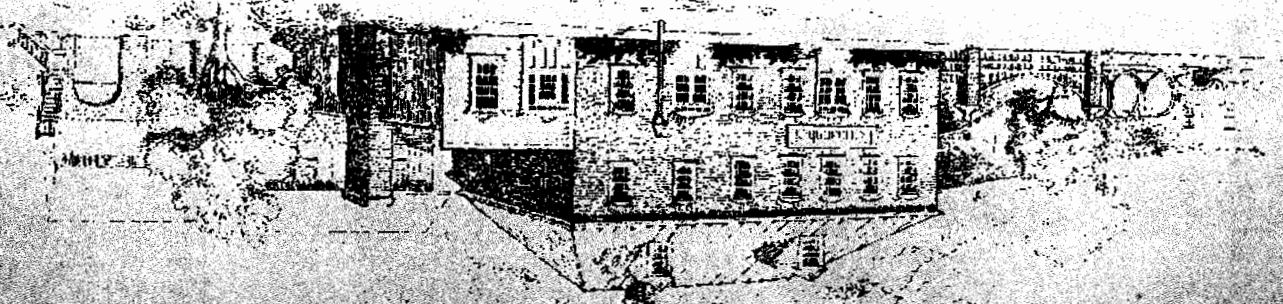

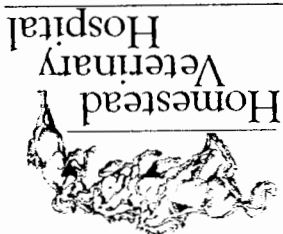

Jane Savoie Clinic...

The United States Dressage Federation (USDF) is pleased to announce that Jane Savoie, who has been a member of the United States Equestrian Team and a popular clinician and author, is clinician for the nine adult clinics beginning in March 24-25 in Region 4, April 14-15 in Region 8, and October 13-14 in Region 5. The theme for the clinics is "Believe You Can; Ride the Possibilities," focusing on Ms. Savoie's sports psychology first expounded in her bestselling book, "That Winning Feeling".

The clinics will feature a lecture each day as well as riding for USDF members interested in benefiting from Jane's wealth of knowledge and expertise.

The series of clinics is aimed primarily at adult riders are also welcome to attend.

"We are so excited to be working with Jane the next two years," stated Katherine Robertson, Senior Coordinator for the program. "Jane brings a wealth of knowledge on how to eliminate mental barriers in your riding and that is the type of thing that many of our adult amateurs struggle with every day.

Riders and horses participating in these clinics should have a history together in order to maximize the auditor educational experience, but a competitive history is not necessary.

"Jane has also graciously offered to supply auditors with a few handouts and help them maximize their learning experience," adds Kathie. Jane and the USDF really want everyone to benefit from her many years of experience at the highest levels."

In addition to her skills as a coach, competitor, instructor, and clinician, Jane has penned many articles and books such as *That Winning Feeling*, *It's Not Just About the Ribbons*, and *Cross-Train Your Horse Books One and Two*. Jane served as coach to the Canadian Olympic three-day event team in both Atlanta and Athens in 1996 and 2000. In addition, she was the reserve rider for the bronze-medal winning Olympic team at the Barcelona Olympic Games. In a continued effort to pass on her knowledge, Jane has also put together a series of instructional video tapes entitled *The Half-Halt Demystified*, *Putting Your Horse on the Bit*, and *Riding in Your Mind's Eye*.

October 13, 2006 (Lexington, KY.) - United States Dressage Federation (USDF) Youth Executive Board is pleased to announce that Colleen Akin, Martina Riker, Hannah Holland Shook, and Mary B. Lauritsen have been selected as this year's recipients of the USDF Youth Convention Scholarships for the 2006 Adequan/USDF National Convention and Symposium, to be held November 29-December 3 in Kansas City, Missouri. These individuals were selected based on their commitment to the sport of dressage, their keen desire to pursue continuing education, and their ability and willingness to share their learning experiences with others. The recipients will be granted a discounted registration fee to attend the 2006 Adequan/USDF National Convention, and each will receive up to a \$1,000 scholarship to help defray the cost of attending.

Colleen Akin, 15, from Warwick, New York, is a tenth grade honor student at Warwick Valley Middle School. In 2006, Colleen earned her USDF Bronze medal, was the Reserve Champion at the USDF Dressage Equitation Medal Finals, competed on the Silver Medal team at the Region 8 Youth Team Championships, and earned the Overall Bronze Medal at the Youth Dressage Festival in Saugerties, New York. Colleen is currently competing through Third Level. One of her mounts is a 6 year old Oldenburg mare that Colleen has trained from the start. Colleen is a USDF Shining Star Award recipient, and actively volunteers her time for Dressage 4 Kids and for the Winslow Therapeutic Riding Center. In her scholarship application, Colleen wrote, "While in California at the Dressage Seat Finals I learned so much by meeting young people from different areas. I can only imagine that convention would be a similar experience on a larger scale. I would not be able to attend a convention without support, and if I receive the scholarship, I would 'pay it forward' by assisting others in the sport in the future."

Martina Riker, 12, from Haiku, Hawaii is a devoted dressage enthusiast. She devours any learning opportunity offered through the Hawaii State Dressage Society, having attended the USDF Adult Clinic Series, as well as numerous clinics with well-known dressage trainers. Martina's goal is to help those on the island of Maui to feel as though they are part of the dressage community. "I want to inspire other young riders on Maui to go after their goals. I will try to help the future of dressage on Maui, and wherever I go in the future."

Hannah Holland Shook, 15, from Charlotte, North Carolina is an active member of USDF, USEF, and the North Carolina and South Carolina Dressage and Combined Training Associations. A USDF Bronze Medalist, Hannah has achieved much competitive success in 2006, earning the Overall Individual Championship at the USEF National Junior Dressage Team Championship in Pebble Beach, California, as well as riding on the gold medal winning team from Region 1. Hannah has ridden in USDF Junior Young Rider clinics, participates in as many as nine dressage clinics annually with top trainers, and takes advantage of USDF University credit programs to augment her education. Hannah actively volunteers her time for the NCDCTA, and is an active participant in her school's Dance Team and Equestrian Club.

Mary Bahniuk Lauritsen, 17, currently competes at Fourth Level and in the FBI Junior tests. She participated recently in the USDF Region 8 FBI Jr/YR clinic with Susan Blinks and is an active member of the Connecticut Dressage Association, Charles River Dressage Association, and New England Dressage Association. She also plays Junior Varsity Lacrosse. Mary writes, "I am at a turning point in my life. This spring I am graduating from high school and making important decisions about my future in the sport of dressage. By receiving this






