### **PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE 2011 SLADS BYLAWS**

# PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE 2011 SLADS BYLAWS

In summary, the proposed Amendment No. 1 does the following:

- 1) Deletes the write-in option on the ballot. The right to nominate from the floor of the meeting remains.
- 2) All nominees to the SLADS Board of Directors must meet the following criteria:
  - a. Must be a member in good standing (i.e., paid their dues and completed a membership form at the time of the election.)
  - b. Must have been contacted and agreed to the nomination PRIOR to being nominated.
  - c. If nominated from the floor at the Annual Meeting, in addition to being a member in good standing and previously agreeing to the nomination, the nominee must be physically present at the election meeting.
- 3) Prior to the election of Board Members, the general membership will be informed of the number of positions on the Board which are open for election and the names of all people running for those positions.
- 4) All SLADS members in good standing may mail their signed ballots to the SLADS Secretary prior to voting at the Annual meeting. Ballots received after the election at the Annual meeting will not be considered.

## PROPOSED CHANGE

3. The Nominating Committee shall notify the Secretary of the names of the persons so nominated at least thirty days (30) days prior to the Annual Meeting. The Secretary shall submit a ballot of nominees to be published in the newsletter and posted on the website no less than fifteen (15) days prior to the Annual Meeting. The ballot will list the names along with the number of positions open for election.
4. All SLADS members in good standing are eligible to vote. If unable to attend the Annual Meeting, a member may complete and sign a ballot which must be received by the SLADS Secretary prior to the Annual Meeting. Ballots received after the date of the Annual Meeting will not be considered.
5. At the Annual Meeting, nominations will be accepted from the floor. In the case of a nomination from the floor, the suggested nominee must be a current member of SLADS in good standing, must be physically present at the meeting in which the election is held, and their consent to be nominated must be obtain prior to nomination. The Nominating Committee will ensure that the names of all nominees for elected position(s) along with the number of positions presently open are known to the electing membership at the Annual Meeting prior to the actual election.

## CURRENT

The Bylaws (approved 22 Jan 2011) regarding the Nominating Committee and the process for nominating members to the Board of Directors. (Section 10.11 C) are written as follows:

C. Nominating Committee.

1. The Board of Directors shall appoint, in September, a Nominating Committee of two (2) to four (4) members of SLADS. The Nominating Committee shall consist of at least one Board member. Every effort should be made to select the remaining members of the Nominating Committee from the membership.
2. It shall be the duty of the Committee to determine the open positions on the Board of Directors, as defined by these bylaws and Standing Rules, and to provide to the membership the list of open positions along with their associated duties. The Committee will accept nominations for the listed positions from the membership. In all cases, consent of the suggested nominee must be obtained prior to the nomination.
3. The Nominating Committee shall notify the Secretary of the names of the persons so nominated at least sixty (60) days prior to the Annual Meeting. The Secretary shall submit a ballot of nominees with space for write-ins to all current members no less than thirty (30) days prior to the last date on which the ballots must be returned. Nominations will be accepted from the floor at the Annual Meeting and added to the ballot. Again, consent of the suggested nominee must be obtained prior to nomination.

## **SLADS Board Meeting Minutes February 21, 2011**

**Present: Ann Gioia, Pam Davies, Liz Drew, Mari Jebens, Trish Dalton, Debbie Price, Sarah Szachnieski, Kathy Yamaguchi, Jessie Fee**

Ann opened the meeting by welcoming Sarah and Kathy. Jessie Fee arrived later and was welcomed at that time.

### **Budget:**

- Budget for 2011 presented by Debbie Price. Budget is based on 2009 income for shows because this is typical of a year following a Regional Championship year.
- Budget was reviewed for each line item and discussed.
- Discussion was held on possibly changing banks from US Bank to another bank because of fees incurred at US Bank for checking acct.
- Discussion was held about the expense of the banquet, and it was discussed that a family membership should include 2 meal tickets for the banquet.
- Discussion was held that after the June show is complete we look at income from it and decide if we need to do a fundraiser to help cover the cost of the banquet.
- Budget for 2011 was tabled for next meeting when a better idea of budget for show will be available.

### **2011 Show Committee:**

It was noted that there was no signed contract for show manager Sandi Lewis or show secretary's Libby Abbott and Susan England for the 2011 shows for either June or October. Debbie and Ann will work to get the contract put together for Sandi, Libby and Susan.

- Debbie has prepared a Request for Bid (RFB) for the 2012 shows for both the show manager and the show secretary. Discussion was held that these positions should be advertised outside of just the SLADS organization.
- Jessie Fee will be the head of the show committee and anyone who wants to help out is welcome.
- Ann, Debbie and Mari are going to meet with Liz at the NEC to finalize contracts for the 2011 shows and schooling shows in the next week. Discussion was held to try and get a long term contract with NEC so plans could be made further into the future.
- Judges have been hired for the 2011 and 2012 season. It was discussed and decided to move the June show back to the first full weekend in June due to heat.
- Hotel accommodations were discussed; judges were displeased at being in a hotel without any restaurants and no transportation to take them for dining. It was recommended to look into rates at the Hilton as a comparison. Ann will call and ask about this.

**Vendors:** Kathy Yamaguchi offered to take over vendors for the recognized shows for Mari. Mari accepted.

**Schooling Show:** Tentative dates have been set but Mari will meet with Liz to firm these up this week.

**Awards:** Sally was unable to attend due to family matters, Trish gave her report. Everyone commented on how well the banquet went and how beautiful the platters and dishes were that were done for the recognized ribbons. Sally and Trish got Manna Pro treats donated. There are not enough for the first place prizes so Sally and Trish are looking into another item. Trish said there were some extra bud vases remaining in the locker from October and offered them to Mari for the schooling show.

**Education Committee:** Pam has several items being planned for education including a workshop with Dr. Cassells, a Purina nutritionist, a chiropractor, and Ed Huecker, farrier. This is scheduled for April 9<sup>th</sup>. She also has a Balance and Fitness workshop donated by Liz Drew in the planning mode, and a Test Riding Symposium with "s" judges.

### New Business:

- Tiffany Stageman sent an email requesting SLADS to sponsor a track sign for Relay for Life. Following discussion a decision was made not to fund this item because it was not horse related.
- Debbie discussed the AQHA fees, \$50 a show, as well as advertisement outlets for this item. Discussion was held that this has good potential to bring in riders outside of SLADS.
- Nick Ivanovich was elected to the SLADS board and has declined his position. Liz asked about voting for another board member and what is the process. Process is to bring a nomination to the table at the next meeting, and voted on by the SLADS membership the following month.

The next meeting is scheduled for March 14 at 7 PM location TBA.

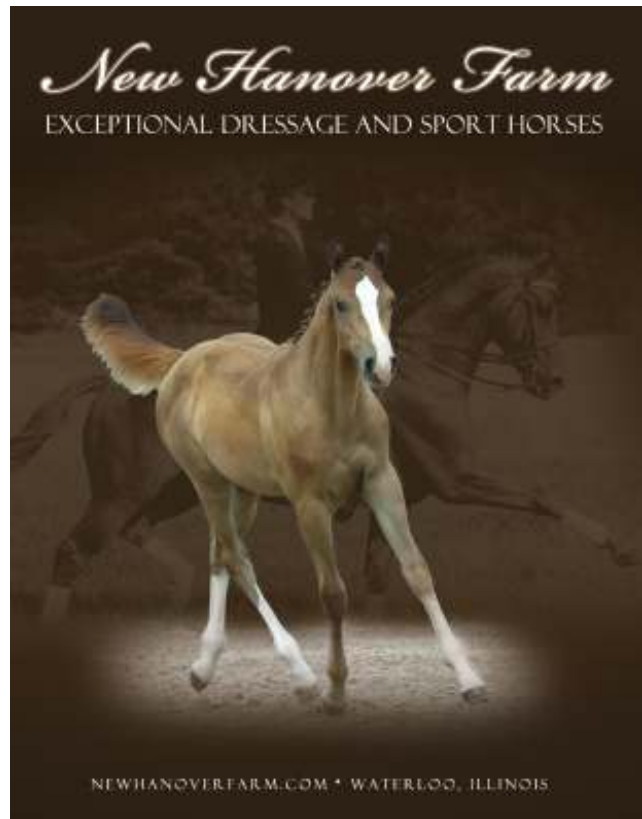
